
- ◆ 体験レッスンは1回目はDay1を、2回目はDay2を利用下さい。

VERSANT COURSE DAY 1

PART A - READING:

INSTRUCTION: READ THE SENTENCES OUT LOUD WHEN YOU HEAR THE SENTENCE NUMBER.

- 1. Anton lost the brand-new watch given by his parents.
- 2. He has been looking for it all over the school.
- 3. He has trouble remembering where he had taken it off.
- 4. After a few hours of looking, he found it on one of the tables in the cafeteria.
- 5. Micky enjoys playing sports as a hobby.
- 6. Among all the sports Micky plays, soccer is his favorite.
- 7. On weekends, he usually plays soccer with friends at the park.
- 8. He is also a member of the soccer team at school.
- 9. Sarah is inviting her best friend to her home for dinner.
- 10. She is planning to cook her favorite, soup curry.
- 11. Then, she realized that she had not gone grocery shopping yet.
- 12. She decided to order ready-to-cook Japanese food instead.

VERSANT COURSE

PART B - REPEAT:

INSTRUCTION: YOU WILL HEAR 15 SENTENCES. REPEAT EACH SENTENCE WORD-FOR-WORD.

PART C - QUESTIONS:

INSTRUCTION: GIVE A SIMPLE ANSWER TO EACH QUESTION. YOUR ANSWER SHOULD BE ONE TO FOUR WORDS, RATHER THAN A FULL SENTENCE.

PART D - SENTENCE BUILDS

INSTRUCTION: REARRANGE THE WORDS OR GROUPS OF WORDS THAT YOU HEAR TO FORM A QUESTION OR SENTENCE.

PART E - STORY RETELLING

INSTRUCTION: YOU WILL HEAR A STORY. YOU WILL HEAR THE STORY ONCE. YOU WILL HAVE 30 SECONDS TO RETELL THE STORY. TELL AS MUCH OF THE STORY AS YOU CAN, INCLUDING THE NAMES, ACTION, AND ENDING.

TIPS: REMEMBER TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING IN YOUR RESPONSE - THE PERSON OR PEOPLE INVOLVED, THE PLACE, THE EVENT AND THE EMOTION ABOUT IT, AND THE OUTCOME OR RESULT.

PART F - OPEN QUESTIONS

INSTRUCTION: YOU WILL HEAR A QUESTION ABOUT FAMILY LIFE OR PERSONAL SITUATIONS THAT ARE FAMILIAR TO YOU. THE QUESTIONS WILL BE SPOKEN TWICE. YOU WILL HAVE 20 SECONDS TO THINK AND ANOTHER 40 SECONDS TO GIVE YOUR RESPONSE.

TIPS: REMEMBER TO MENTION THESE POINTS IN YOUR RESPONSE - YOUR OPINION, EXAMPLES OR EXPLANATIONS, AND ANY FURTHER INFORMATION. DO NOT BE CONCERNED ABOUT THE OPINION THAT YOU EXPRESS. YOU WILL BE ASSESSED ON YOUR LANGUAGE SKILLS, NOT ON YOUR VIEWPOINT.

VERSANT COURSE DAY 2

PART A - READING:

INSTRUCTION: READ THE SENTENCES OUT LOUD WHEN YOU HEAR THE SENTENCE NUMBER.

- 1. Gina is going on a vacation to the Philippines.
- 2. She has been dreaming about visiting the country with her friends.
- 3. She is looking forward to swimming at the beautiful beaches.
- 4. Her friends can't wait to taste the Philippines' famous dishes, too.
