<3. RLC: Reading, Listening, Comprehension>

- 50分レッスンの場合は後半がRLCです。当校の音読トレーニングを実施します。難しい方も簡単に感じる方もいると思いますが、レベル判定後、適切な教材をご紹介しますのでご安心ください。リピーティングやシャドウイングのやり方を体感下さい。
- 特に速読力、リスニング力の向上の他、スピーキング力も向上します。英語を英語のまま理解するための英語脳を作ります。
- 「Comprehension Questions」ではこの文章を使って講師とQ&Aをしますので、ぜひ自分の意見を英語で述べて下さい。

<4. Speaking Activity>

- テーマについて英語で自分の意見を述べる練習です。スピーキング力向上に効果があります。英検の二次試験でも必須です。もちろん事前に辞書などで調べて頂いて構いません。この繰り返しが英語力を伸ばします。

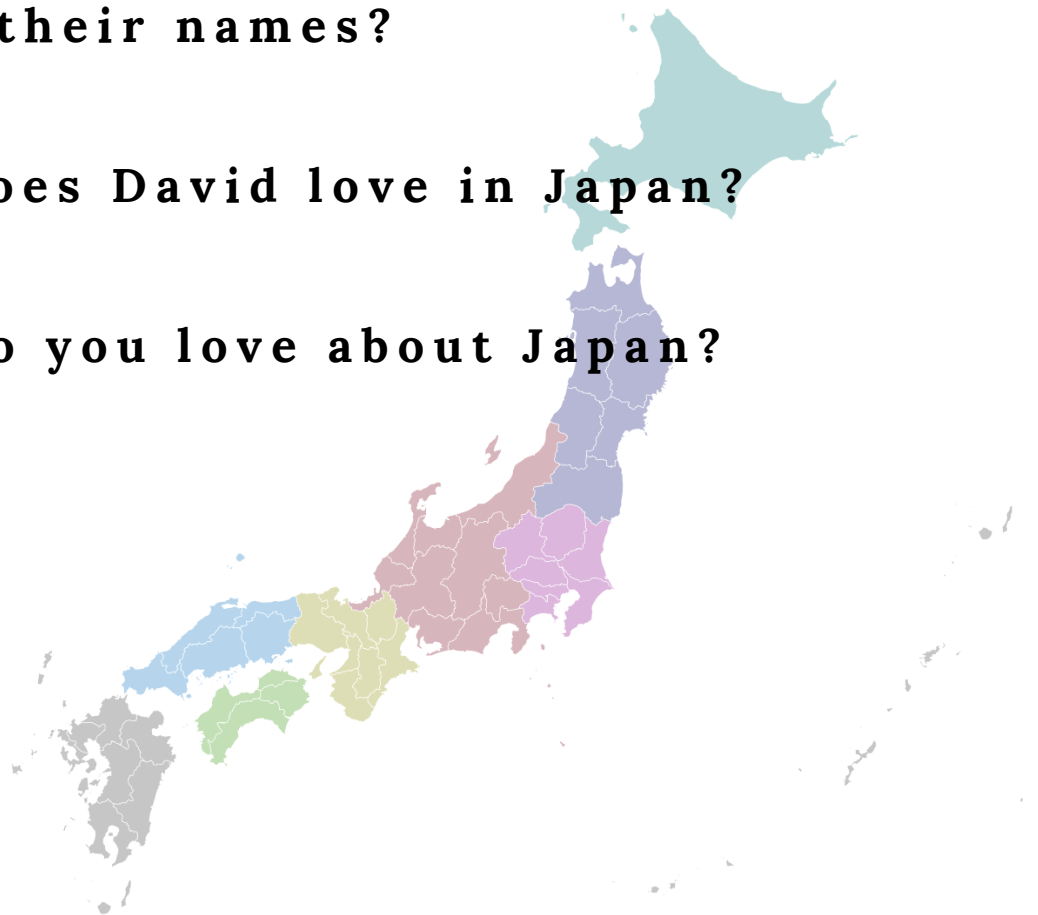

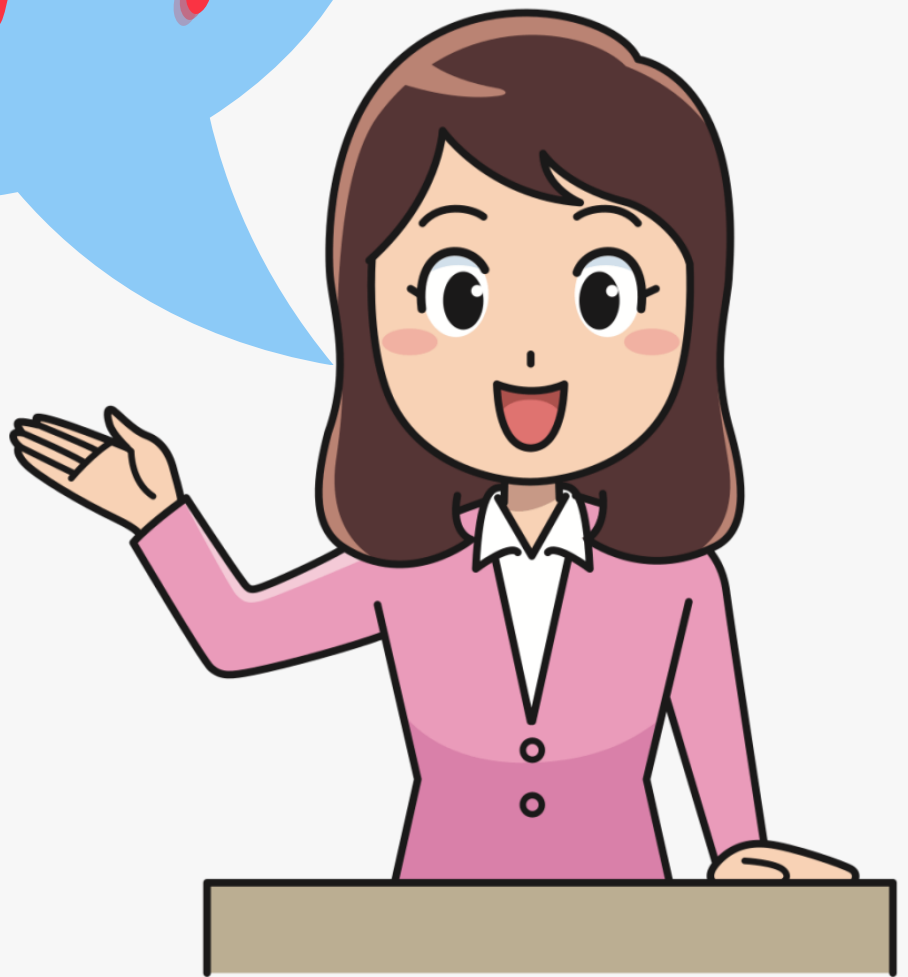

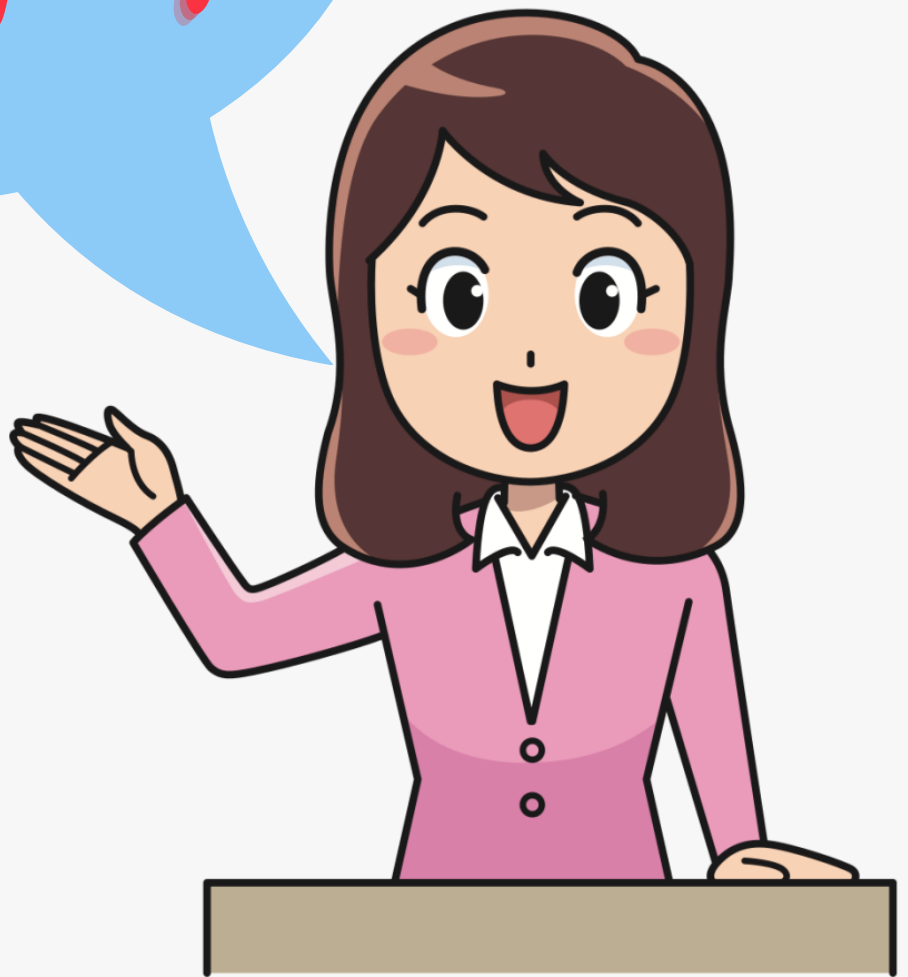
